- prepare discussion documents, summary minutes and otherwise support WHEB's independent Advisory Committee;
- participate in and respond to government consultations;
- represent WHEB on key investment and industry networks; and,
- support the research and development of WHEB white-papers and wider commentary on impact investing.

You will also work closely with WHEB's investment team(s) to deliver:

- well-researched and insightful stock-level impact analysis;
- coordinate and support engagement with companies to advocate for more progressive approaches to material sustainability issues and deliver investment relevant insights; and

The successful applicant will have, as a minimum:

- ideally expertise working in financial services;
- a demonstrable understanding of – and passion for – sustainable and environmental investing;
- an excellent academic record ideally covering sustainability/environmental science and financial analysis; and,
- excellent written and oral communication skills.

- work in a small, close-knit team, where challenge and reasoned discussion are expected and rewarded;
- demonstrate leadership from an early stage, helping to integrate thematic research and impact analysis into investment decisions; and,
- organise a varied workload.
